Team up with a friend or give us a ring and we will do our best to fit you in with another group if possible.

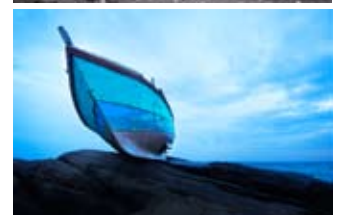
WHAT TO BRING:

Fees and Payment

To secure your booking, we require full payment at the time of booking.

The workshop cost includes the tuition fee only, unless stated otherwise. All other expenses are the responsibility of the participant.

Refunds

If for any reason you need to cancel your participation in a workshop and you notify us at least 7 days prior to the workshop, we will refund your fee.

If notification is within 7 days we will retain the workshop fee unless the vacant spot can be filled.

Workshop group sizes may vary but will generally be based on a minimum of 4 participants and a maximum of 10.
